Rothesay Road Water Main Extension and Sewer Improvements

June 16, 2010

The Town of Rothesay will be installing a new water main improving the sanitary sewer system on Rothesay Road from Dunedin Road to Eden Drive. The construction will include the following:

- Approximately 3760 meters of new water main from Dunedin Road to James Renforth Drive (across from Eden Drive), under the CN Rail overpass, through the Bishop's Property and connecting to the existing Park Drive water main near Partridge Road.
- Approximately 980 meters of new gravity sanitary sewer on Rothesay Road from Civic # 2242 (between Appleby and Bartlett lane), west to Birchview Terrace.
- Approximately 760 meters of 150 mm diameter sanitary force main on the Bishop's Property from the Kennebecasis Park Sewage Treatment Lagoon site.
- New 20 mm water services from the new water main will be installed (directional drilling) to each property line fronting Rothesay Road between Dunedin and Eden Drive. Property owners will be contacted to discuss desired location.

The construction along Rothesay Road is scheduled to begin June 21st, 2010 and is scheduled for substantial completion by March 2011.

Rothesay Road will be reduced to one lane with flaggers for alternating traffic at times during construction. Please use an alternate route if possible to avoid the construction area. The work on Rothesay Road within the City of Saint John limits has been delayed and existing traffic patterns during that construction will be continuing until mid to late July according to the City.

The Town of Rothesay apologizes for any inconvenience this utility upgrade will cause to the resident of Rothesay.
