Due to the growing number of mild to severe peanut allergies among children, we ask parents to refrain from sending peanut butter, peanuts, or any other food item that may contain peanuts to camp. If your child has any other allergies please be sure to mark them on your registration form.



## HANDS-OFF POLICY

We want to keep our programs safe and enjoyable for all campers. As a result, we have a hands-off policy. The goal of this policy is zero tolerance for violence and bullying. If either occurs, the offending camper will be suspended from camp for one day. This policy is explained at the beginning of camp, but it is important that parents/guardians also communicate the policy with their children to avoid any undesirable situations. Please note, there will be no refunds for the days suspended campers miss.
