1 October 2019, Rothesay, NB - A strong contingent of Rothesay youth participated in a climate strike at Rothesay Town Hall on Friday, September 27. The school strike movement was inspired by Greta Thunberg, the 16 year old student from Sweden.



Mayor Grant addressed the crowd, noting that Rothesay participated in the Climate Change & Energy Initiative (CCEI), in partnership with the Union of Municipalities of New Brunswick (UMNB).

Rothesay Council set the target of reducing corporate GHG emissions by 15% by 2023, compared to their 2015 reference level and also set the target of reducing community GHG emissions by 7% by 2025 and 14% by 2035 from their 2015 baseline.
