



Coronavirus Response – Rothesay

18 March 2020 Rothesay, NB: Effective March 18th, the Rothesay Town Office is closed to the public. This is in response to the Governments' call to maintain social distancing and limit personal interaction.

Essential services will continue including water and sewer services, garbage collection and road maintenance. Development services and building inspection will continue and contact should be made by phone or email - Rothesay@Rothesay.ca or 848-6600. All Rothesay indoor facilities are closed to the public and will remain so until further notice. This includes the Rothesay Arena and Bill McGuire Memorial Centre.

Outdoor facilities including trails and parks remain available for use by the public individually or in small groups.

All Committee meetings are postponed indefinitely.

Rothesay staff is following prescribed protocols as they carry out their duties and this will govern the manner and rapidity with which their work is completed.

The Kennebecasis Valley Fire Department and the Kennebecasis Regional Police have implemented contingency plans to maintain basic services.

These steps and others are designed to mitigate risks to our staff and reduce potential for spreading the Coronavirus through Town sponsored activities. Mayor Grant and the Rothesay Council wish to assure you that steps are being taken to ensure business continuity of all essential Town services. We rely on your cooperation and bringing to our attention any emergencies involving Town infrastructure and facilities.
