The solid waste collection in Rothesay is intended to stay as normal. Curbside collection is unchanged - Please put out your garbage, recycling and compost in the separate bins as usual on your normal collection day before 7:00 a.m.

## Collection and rules stay the same

Collection schedules are staying the same. And what you can put in your compost bin or recycling bins is staying the same. Please put out the correct things on the correct day. Due to COVID-19 all collected materials are going to garbage, but municipalities are being charged the compost rate (which is much lower) for compost that is collected. This will keep your Town on budget and makes it worthwhile to separate your waste. And it keeps us in the correct routines for when all of this is over.

If you are able, you can store your paper/cardboard until the situation changes.
