

COVID-19 ADAPPTIONS

THIS IS NOT A DROP-OFF PROGRAM

Pre-screening will be done each time the camper arrives. Please remain 2 meters away from other guardians and campers during sign in. Bill McGuire Group A campers will sign-in at Entrance A (Left Main Entrance) and Group B will sign-in at Entrance B (Right Side Entrance).

Guardians must sign the pre-screening survey on behalf of their campers. Campers and staff who do not pass the survey will not be allowed to stay. Campers will be required to sanitize their hands prior to entering the facilities. Guardians are not to enter the facilities.

If your child develops symptoms while at day camp you will be called immediately and are asked to pick them up within an hour. Your camper will be isolated from the group with supervision and asked to wear their community face mask while they wait to be picked up. Sanitization will follow. Public Health will be contacted.

HOW TO REGISTER

You can register and provide payment for your campers at Rothesay Town Hall. Please note that camp runs from Monday to Friday with a limit of 15 campers in each weekly group. Accepted methods of payment: cash, debit, or cheque.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- χ **Cell phones or personal gaming devices:** Children will not be permitted to use these at camp so please leave them at home for safe keeping.
- χ **Leave your own toys at home:** We have lots of great things to do at our programs and we must follow all Provincial requirements regarding COVID-19.
