
Next Rothesay Council Meeting

National Day of Remembrance & Action on Violence Against Women

On December 6, we recognize the National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women. A day to remember the tragic mass shooting at l'École Polytechnique de Montréal (December 6, 1989) that took the lives of 14 young women.

2023 Budget Highlights

General Operating Fund 2023 Highlights

- 1. Total Operating Budget \$21.76 million
- 2. 10.55% increase in aggregate property tax assessments
- 3. Decrease the tax rate to \$1.19 per \$100 of assessment a 1 cent decrease
- 4. Increase the mark-up % re non-residential properties to 170%.
- 5. Aggregate warrant of assessment = \$20,123.778

Utility Operating Fund 2023 Highlights

- 1. Total Revenue \$3,865,000
- 2. Revenue from sale of water of \$1,155,000 includes a 5% increase in rates (base water rate \$1.24 per cubic metre and \$215 per annum fixed fee)
- 3. Revenue from sewerage services \$1,942,500 includes a 5% increase of \$25 to an annual base rate of \$435 per equivalent user per year
- Aggregate "typical" residential utility fees total approximately \$1,000 annually
