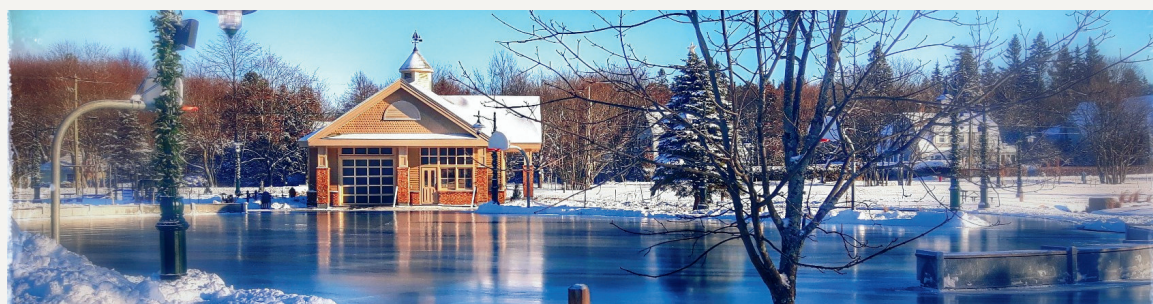

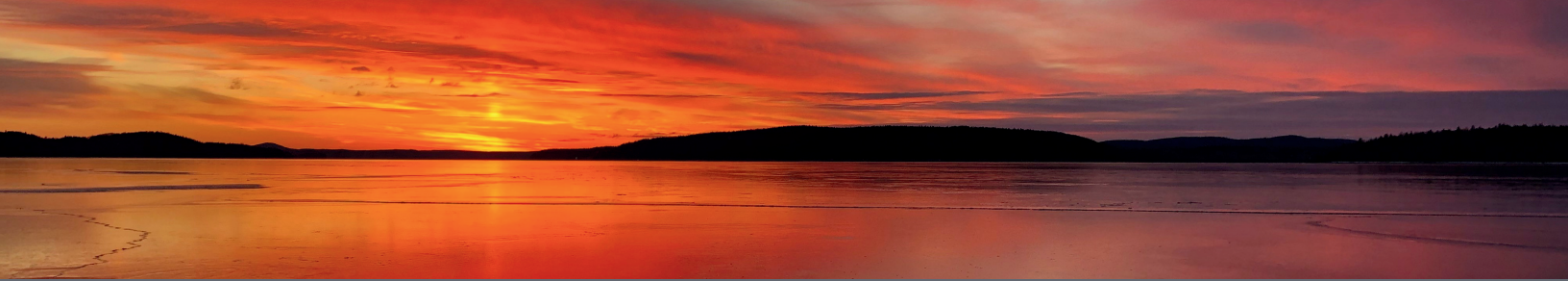

Every pet owner must license their dog or cat at Rothesay Town Hall. It is free with proof of vaccinations and the tag is valid for the animal's lifetime or until change in ownership.

Dogs MUST always be on a leash when on public property (any property that is not privately owned by you). This includes ALL Town Trails and Sports Fields. Please visit the Dog Park at Wells Recreation Park, 75 French Village Road, to enjoy a fenced-in area!
