## **Wastewater Treatment Facility Upgrade Project**

Rothesay, NB

Rothesay ("the Town") has been approved for financial support under Infrastructure Canada's (INFC) Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) to upgrade its wastewater treatment facilities.

- The Town is proposing to upgrade its lagoon-based wastewater treatment system to a new mechanical wastewater treatment facility (WWTF) to be constructed at the site of the existing Fairvale Lagoon, along the east side of the Kennebecasis River.
- The Town has retained Dillon Consulting Limited in partnership with Jacobs Engineering Group Inc. for the design of the new WWTF.





