Mayor's Message

Happy Fall Everyone!

Although, like many of you, I can't believe the summer is gone!

What a beautiful summer it was - although it seems that climate change has found its way to New Brunswick, with the drought we have experienced. As we contemplate the possibility of future droughts, it may be time for us as a community to give serious thought to water conservation and also begin to look at how each of us individually can do our part.

But the mornings are now cooler, and fall routines are in place. Rothesay's activities will

soon begin, with the Rothesay Arena opening on Monday, October 6, and our Halloween Costume Skate scheduled for the Arena on Sunday, October 26, 3-4 pm. The Annual KV Santa Claus Parade takes place on Saturday, November 29, at 6pm, and the Annual Mayor's Tree lighting will happen on the Rothesay Common on Wednesday, December 10, at 7pm, with a storm date of December 17.

Council and Staff are working hard to bring our #1 priority to life: a new arena and walking track, and conversion of our old arena into indoor court space, a new home for the growing Rothesay HIVE, community gathering space and a community policing office. This Rothesay Intergenerational Community Complex (RICC) project is currently in fundraising mode, and donations from residents and the community are welcome. There will be a number of community fundraising events this fall; please support these if you can:

- REDHAWKS BATTLE AT THE NEST in support of the RICC 14-16

Operations

Fall Clean-Up 2025

All items must be placed curbside by 7:00am on Monday regardless of your scheduled pick-up day.

Organic Waste Pick-Up - Monday, November 3rd

This clean-up will be for the collection of leaves and yard waste for composting. Residents are encouraged to compost these materials on their own property for use in landscaping and gardening, but if this is not appropriate or desirable, the annual pickup provides an environmentally sound means of disposal.

- Leaves, grass clippings, & bundled twigs with twine no longer than 4ft and weighing no
- more than 40lbs. No trees larger than 4 inches in diameter.

 Residents are required to use brown paper bags for yard waste.
- Yard waste in plastic bags (clear, black or any colour) will **NOT** be collected.
- Please **DO NOT** use your compost cart for this pick-up.


 Construction and demolition materials (such as plywood or pressure-treated lumber), household junk, garbage, or hazardous materials (paints, tires, propane tanks, white goods, etc.) WILL NOT be picked up.
