Tournament Rules

Preliminary Games

- All games will be three, fifteen-minute, stop-time periods.
- Rules will be in accordance with Hockey Canada Official Rules and SSNB Operating Regulations. If a player is given a match penalty they will be out for the remainder of the tournament. Home team will wear dark jersey and it is to be indicated on game sheet.
- Every player and team official competing must be listed in the Game Sheet app before the tournament. No additions will be accepted without prior authorization of the Tournament Committee.
- Referees decisions are final. No protests will be entertained.
- Floods will occur after the 10-minute pre-game warm-up and during the 2nd intermission. The exception to this
 will be the first game of the day Friday Sunday that will see a 10-minute pre-game warm up, immediately followed by the
 first two periods. Teams should be ready to go on the ice 20 minutes prior to the game time on the schedule. Warm-up
 times may be adjusted to keep the tournament on schedule.
- Regulation wins are worth 3 points; overtime and shootout wins are worth 2 points; and overtime losses count 1 point.
- In preliminary games, during the third period, if one team is ahead by five (or more) goals the remainder of the
 game will be played straight (running time).
- Teams are permitted one timeout per game.

Overtime

- In the event of a tie after regulation, teams will switch ends and there will be a five minute 3 on 3, sudden death overtime period.
- If teams are still tied after the overtime period, there will be a shootout.

Shootout

- The home team has the option to shoot first or second.
- Each team will choose three different shooters.
- If a player has a penalty that has not expired at the end of the overtime period, they are not eligible for the shootout
- If the teams are tied after three shooters, they will proceed to sudden-death rounds until a winner is declared.
 Coaches can recycle players after the 5th round of shooters is completed and the score is still tied.

Plavoff Games

- All playoff games, including the Championship Final, will be three fifteen-minute stop-time periods.
- In the event of a tie after regulation in the semi-finals and finals, there will be a ten minute 3 on 3 sudden-death overtime period.
- If the teams are still tied at the completion of the overtime period, there will be a shootout (same shootout rules as preliminary games).
 - 1. In the case of a tie after preliminary round robin play, the following tie breaking rules shall be used:
 - 1) If 2 teams are tied:
 - a) The team winning head to head
 - b) The highest ratio of goals for minus goals against in all games played.
 - c) The team with the least goals against in all games played.
 - d) The team with the least amount of penalty minutes in all round robin games played.
 - 2) If more than 2 teams are tied:
 - a) The highest ratio of goals for minus goals against in all games played.
 - b) The team with the least penalty minutes in all round robin games played.
 - c) The toss of a coin.
 - 2. The tournament committee's decisions shall be final.

Dressing rooms will be listed on a board in the lobby of the arena.
