

COMPOST

All food & yard waste goes in your kitchen bin & Green Cart

All Food Waste

- Breads
- Fruit & vegetable scraps
- Meat, bones, fish & shellfish including shells
- Dairy products, eggshells
- Nuts & shells
- Coffee filters & grounds, tea bags
- Grease & fat

Food Soiled Paper Products

- Soiled paper towels & napkins
- Used paper plates
- Paper flour & sugar bags
- Pizza boxes
- Parchment paper

Yard Waste

- Leaves
- Weeds
- Twigs & branches less than 2" in diameter & 4' in length

Place yard waste directly in your cart. Make sure there are no branches sticking out of your cart & the lid can close.

Compostable bags must have one of these symbols:







RECYCLING CURBSIDE

Sort your recyclables into the 2 boxes.



Papers

Paper

- Newspaper & flyers
- Office paper & envelopes
- Catalogues, phone books
- Magazines, brochures & glossy paper
- Soft cover books
- Hard cover books remove cover
- Paper Gift wrap no tape or ribbons
- Shredded paper place in a clear plastic bag or paper bag. (This is the only item that should be bagged)

Cardboard Flatten all boxes

- Packaging boxes
- Cereal & cracker boxes (remove liner)
- Tissue boxes
- Egg cartons
- Paper towel cores



Containers Plastic, Metal & Milk



- Milk, juice jugs
- Yogurt, sour cream & cream cheese
- Ice cream tubs (plastic)
- Ketchup, & salad dressing bottles
- Shampoo bottles
- Bleach & detergent bottles
- Beverage containers (no glass)

Milk Cartons

- Milk, cream & buttermilk cartons
- Tetra paks

Metal Containers

- All food & pet food cans
- Aluminum pie plates & foil
- Pop cans

Remember, items should be loose in the bins, flatten all boxes and don't include plastic bags.

REDEMPTION CENTRES

Recycle MORE at **Redemption Centres**

Take to a redemption centre for recycling (not accepted curbside).

- Flexible plastics (plastic bags & soft plastics)
- White styrofoam
- Glass jars
- Beverage cardboard



GARBAGE

- Coffee cups and lids
- Dryer sheets & lint
- Bottle caps & lids
- Plastics straws & cutlery



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

HHW accepted at Crane Mountain Landfill year round, 6 days a week.

Typical HHW items:

Batteries (household/car), bleach, cleaning products, CFL bulbs, driveway sealant, fertilizers, insecticides, tires, paints and thinners, pool chemicals, propane tanks. Electronics - TV's, computers, cell phones, audio systems & peripherals.

COMPOST

RECYCLING CURBSIDE

TIPS:

- Line your kitchen bin with a sheet of newspaper to absorb moisture
- Empty and rinse bin regularly
- Layer yard waste between kitchen scraps to combat odours.
- Additional yard waste can be put in paper leaf & vard waste bags.

DO NOT INCLUDE:

- **x** Ashes
- x Coffee cups
- x Plastic bags
- x Cigarette butts
- **x** Wax paper
- **x** Styrofoam
- **x** Tree stumps
- x Rocks & gravel
- **x** Bricks
- **x** Branches larger than 2" in diameter

Compostable bags must have one of these symbols:

TIPS:

- The lid can be used on either box. On windy or rainy days, please put the lid on the papers' box and place it on top of the containers' box.
- Do not bag items. Place recyclables loose in the box.
- Remember that flexible plastics are no longer recyclable curbside. This includes bread bags, Ziploc bags, stand-up pouches, saran wrap and wrap on things like paper towel (bring to redemption centre).
- Look for the recycling symbols 1, 2 or 5.



- Flatten all cardboard boxes.
- Large cardboard boxes should be flattened and placed under or between recycling boxes. Large quantities can be tied in bundles no larger than 30" x 30" x 8" (76 cm x 76 cm x 20 cm).
- Remember, plastic straws and cutlery are garbage.
- Soiled paper, like pizza boxes, paper plates and fast food wrappers should go in the compost.
- Rinse containers thoroughly.

DO NOT INCLUDE:

- x Flexible plastics (bring to remption centre), including grocery bags, pouches, bread bags and plastic wrap
- **X** Black garbage bags
- **X** Wet or dirty cardboard
- **x** Coffee cups or lids
- **X** Waxed cardboard or paper
- **X** Vinyl siding
- **x** Styrofoam
- **X** Chip bags
- **X** Plastic furniture or toys
- X Plastic straws & cutlery



REDEMPTION CENTRES

TIPS:

Preparing your materials:

- Separate materials from your deposit containers
- Sort materials by material type, into a clear bag.
- Materials should be clean and dry
- Flexible plastics includes plastic bags, pouches, soft packaging and more

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

TIPS:

- There is no charge for HHW
- Household quantities only
- Leave materials in original labelled packages
- Tape ends of lithium batteries
